- 1. **Equipment:** Jim Krick reporting. Nothing to report.
- 2. **Coaches Committee:** Tom Hackman reporting. Sent an email to all coaches from last year about the coach's clinic in May with Coach Moyer. Would also like to do one Sunday a month to review plays. Three people responded.

- V. BAFYL: Jim Krick reporting. During the February 2019 meeting Jim and Tom Troup attended. Two main topics of the meeting were: age eligibility and a four-team playoff schedule. BAYFL has decided to go back to age based levels. However, the levels will be U13 (for Midgets, the player will not be eligible unless they are under 13 by July 1st, U11 (for Mites, will not be eligible unless they are under 11 by July 1st, and U9 (for Mighty Mites, will not be eligible unless they are under 9 by July 1st. The league is also staying with a four-team playoff and championship will be Sat. Nov 9th at Upper Perkiomen. The semi-final round is Nov 3rd all at one location. The rotation for the championship game goes alphabetically. The semi-final host will be the "ondeck" team with Blue Mountain having the option to host it. If Blue Mountain declines, it becomes our option to host which means we would have to rent a field since lights are required. No date was given as to when a decision has to be submitted. (The host gets to keep the gate fee and concessions fee).
