The league is proposing: Flag – 5 years old, Mighty Mite 6-7 years old, Mite 8-9 years old and Midgets 10-11 years old. CWLS board/coaches do not agree with changes and suggest only to change Mighty Mites to only 7 years old. The proposed BICYFL age changes would incur additional costs to the clubs in regards to uniforms/helmets.
